

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Program Articulation

City College of San Francisco

and

California Institute of Integral Studies

This Agreement is to be used as a guide for the purposes of Admission into the California Institute of Integral Studies as a transfer student. The Office of Admissions will award academic transfer credit as appropriate at the time of admission. All Students who wish to receive an undergraduate degree from CIIS must satisfy the coursework included in the Core Curriculum. All transfer students are encouraged to contact the Office of Admissions for clarification of CIIS procedures and policies at (415) 575-6227.

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is subscribed to by City College of San Francisco ("CCSF") and California Institute of Integral Studies ("CIIS") for the purpose of establishing a credit transfer protocol for students working on the Associate of Arts Degree at CCSF who desire to transfer into an upper division degree completion program at CIIS.

Admission requirements for the California Institute of Integral Studies' School of Undergraduate Studies (CIIS-SUS):

- Student must present a minimum of 60 transferable semester units with a grade earned of "C" or higher.
- Student must satisfy area requirements as outlined in Part I of this agreement.

CIIS-SUS accepts credit from City College of San Francisco as follows:

- All courses designated as CSU-transferable are transferable to CIIS-SUS, *except* for those courses listed in Part II of this agreement.
- Credits earned from courses which may satisfy multiple area requirements will only be applied to one area.
- Credits earned from cross-listed courses will be awarded in one discipline only.
- Credits earned from lab classes will only be accepted when accompanied by appropriate lecture course.
