
## Canvas as Syllabus Repository: Update

Has there been an increase in using Canvas as a Syllabus Repository?

**Fall 2022:** 46.8% of instructors edited the syllabus between August 1, 2022 – Dec 1, 2022

**Spring 2022:** 43% of instructors edited the syllabus between January 1, 2022 – May 1, 2022

**Fall 2021:** 42.2% of instructors edited the syllabus between August 1, 2021 – Dec 1, 2021

Keeping in mind: Editing the syllabus means the instructor clicked on Syllabus and clicked on the Edit button and made *some* edits.

The actual percentage of instructors editing the syllabus includes all users in Canvas with the teacher role (e.g., retired, laid off, no assignment faculty).
