- 20 Upper Division units are awarded for passing NCLEX – the units are considered a part of the student's upper division and 120 unit requirement but not considered residency units

Undergraduate BSN students:

- Must have 70 units before coming to SF State – program requirement; only a maximum of 70 units from Community College accepted
- Must complete 30 units of residency units at SF State; a minimum of 120 units needed to graduate
- Mandatory to attend ADN-BSN orientation and contact the Undergraduate Advising Center if you are missing any GE/University requirement
- 3 upper division GE Courses are required for transfer students, upon successful completion of Nurs 522 and Nurs 530 students will have fulfilled or “Met in Major” General Education Area Upper Division D - Social/Behavioral Sciences (UD-D) and San Francisco State Studies/overlays American Ethnic/Racial Minorities (AERM) and Social Justice (SJ). Undergraduate/transfer students may need additional residence units to graduate - consult with an SF State Undergraduate Advisor
- If you started at SFSU prior to being admitted to the ADN/BSN program, please connect with an undergraduate advisor to ensure you’re following the correct Bulletin (catalog) year
